SURVIVAL INSTRUCTOR	Train cadet to carry out duties of a leader and instructor when delivering survival training at the LHQ.	6 WEEKS	Meet medical standards as per CATO 16.02. When in the field, is <u>NOT</u> within the 20 minutes to medical care.	LEVEL III	Application 2226 and selection boards. See 2008 Nat Summer Trg Selection Memo for Candidate #'s.	Standard First Aid/CPR To act as a survival instructor during LHQ exercise.
SENIOR LEADERS	To train qualified level IV cadets to apply leadership skills at the LHQ.	6 WEEKS	Cold Lake Base Hospital is within 20 minutes. Meet medical standards as per CATO 16.02.	LEVEL IV in current training year Be not less than 15 ½ years as of 1 Sep. of current training year	Application 2226 and selection boards. See 2008 Nat Summer Trg Selection Memo for Candidate #'s.	This Advanced Specialty Course will prepare the cadet to assume leadership positions at the sqn and summer training centres.
SERVICE BAND	The Air Cadet Service Band course is designed to improve musical instrument proficiency and to enhance theoretical knowledge and playing abilities. Through practice and performance, this course will provide cadets with the opportunity to develop leadership skills.	6 Weeks	Cold Lake Base Hospital within 20 minutes.
