POWER PILOT SCHOLARSHIP	To train qualified Cadets to a transport Canada Private pilot licence receiving their Cadet Power Wings.	7 WEEKS	Cadet must possess a class three medical qualification. Meet standards as per CATO 16-02	Minimum Level IV cadet as of 30 Jun of participating year. Cadet must pass a written qualification exam.	See Notes Below (1) & (2)	Cadet Power Wings.
INTRODUCTION TO AVIATION	To develop further the cadet knowledge and skills related to aviation.	3 WEEKS	Regional Gliding School (Gimli) is 20 minutes from Gimli hospital. Meet standards as per CATO 16-02	Level III Cadet by 30 Jun of the Participation year. Or be 15 years of age by course start and have an interest for aviation training.	Cadets must be recommended by their Commanding Officer and approved by the detachment.	Advanced training wrt knowledge and skills related to aviation in preparation for Glider/Power Pilot training.
NOTES	<p>1) Each Squadron is entitled to send (3-5) Candidates who have passed the DND flying exam to selection Boards. DCDTS//League HQ makes the final selection from the provincial league priority list. The number of Candidates the unit is entitled to send depends upon Unit Strength. The total entitlement number is based on a combination of power and gliding. Example: The unit is entitled to 3 candidates if they send 2 Glider they can send 1 Power.</p> <p>2) The Power Pilot Scholarship locations are selected by the RC Air Ops O each year.
